

Connection Manager for Sony Clié Handhelds (Version 1.2)

Requirements:

- Sony Clié Handheld running PalmOS[®] 4.1 or PalmOS[®]5
- A mobile phone with built-in modem and Bluetooth[™] enabled, or with built-in modem and infrared port, or with built-in modem and a serial connection to the Clié

Getting Started







- 1. Please make sure whether Bluetooth[™] is switched on.
- 2. Install Connection Manager (CoMa) with the install tool of your HotSync Software.
- 3. Launch CoMa to set up your connection.

4. Choose your language.

5. Select your country, provider, phone and connection type and tap "Create" to finish.

Some carriers require special usernames and passwords. You got these settings with your contract.

You can change some settings - if necessary - such as username and password by tapping "Advanced"(go to step 6 in this case). This will be usually not necessary, you can setup your connection by tapping on "Create" and continue with step 7. Advanced Settings (?) Use CID 🔻 1 User name: o2wap ? 6. Use the question marks for an explanation of the corresponding settings. Tap "Create" to to create the configuration. If you are not sure what to enter, tap "Cancel", this will restore the default settings.

7. You 'll see this confirmation screen if Sony CoMa has written your connection successfully. You are now able to surf the web or check your email with your Clié with an infrared or serial connection.

If you have choosen a Bluetooth^{TM} connection continue with step 8.

8. (Only for Bluetooth[™] connections!)

Go to the Launcher, run the Prefs application and select Connection from the upper right corner. Choose the entry written by Sony CoMa. Tap "Edit".



 (Only for Bluetooth[™] connections!)
 Please tap on "Tap to discover" to connect your Bluetooth[™] enabled mobile phone to your Clié and to pair it. Make sure your mobile phone is set to "Discovery mode" during the search.

Note: Please end "Discovery mode" to dial into a GPRS network via BluetoothTM.

Important Notes

Known Issues

To surf the web with T-Mobile GPRS with a browser (e.g. NetFront), set up a HTTP-Proxy in the browser preferences: proxy.max.at, Port 3128.

Please make sure to deactivate "GPRS always online" on your mobile phone.

Please make sure that BluetoothTM is not switched on all the time, as it drains the battery fastly.
