Confirming the package contents






Setting up your CLIÉ™ handheld

Perform the following before setting up your CLIÉ handheld.

Step 1: Charging your CLIÉ handheld

Before using your CLIÉ handheld for the first time, make sure you fully charge the battery.



- 1 Connect the AC power adapter to the DC IN connector of the plug adapter.
- **2** Connect the plug adapter to the interface connector of your CLIÉ handheld.
- 3 Connect the AC cord to the AC power adapter (①). Then, plug the AC cord into a wall outlet (②).

 The POWER LED of your CLIÉ handheld turns on when charging starts.

It takes about five hours to fully charge your CLIÉ handheld for the first time. The POWER LED turns off when charging is complete.

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
Subsequent charges will require less time if you charge your CLIÉ handheld frequently.

Note

If the battery of your CLIÉ handheld is completely discharged, all user data stored on your CLIÉ handheld will be lost.

How to remove the plug adapter

Remove by pressing the plug adapter on both sides as illustrated.




Step 2: Performing the initial setup after turning on your CLIÉ handheld for the first time

The first time you turn on your CLIÉ handheld, you need to make some initial settings. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup and to become familiar with operations of your CLIÉ handheld.

1 Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch.

Your CLIÉ handheld turns on, and the **Setup** screen is displayed.



Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch

Note

When you slide and hold the POWER/HOLD switch for more than 2 seconds, the backlight of the LCD display turns on or off.

Tips

If you cannot turn on your CLIÉ handheld

- Did you charge your CLIÉ handheld as described on page 8?

- Perform a soft reset if you cannot turn on your CLIÉ handheld even after charging it (page 47).


2 Take out the stylus.

You can use the stylus to enter text or to select applications.



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You can extend or shorten the stylus, as shown in the illustration.



Notes

- Never use a writing pen, pencil, or other sharp object instead of the stylus to write on your CLIÉ handheld, as the screen may get scratched.
- When you put the stylus back in its holder, push it in into place completely.

3 Following the on-screen instructions, tap exactly in the center of the displayed mark.

Tap the next targets, which are displayed at the bottom right and then in the center of the screen.





The display in the screen depends on where you purchased your CLIÉ handheld.

Note

If the stylus digitizer is not configured correctly, the scroll bar may not operate properly, "tapping" may not work as expected, or other problems may occur.

After the stylus adjustment is complete, a screen for selecting your language is displayed. (Only available for certain models or areas.)

4 Select your language.

(Only available for certain models or areas.)

The **Important** screen is displayed.





The display in the screen depends on where you purchased your CLIÉ handheld.

Click [Yes] to confirm.(Only available for certain models or areas.)



6 Tap the box next to [Set Time:]. The **Set Time** dialog box is displayed.

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You can reconfigure the date and time settings in the **Preferences** screen.

- 7 Tap ▲ or ▼ to set the current time. Tap each box to set the hour and minute.
- **8** Tap [OK].
 The current time is set and the **Setup** screen is displayed.







9 Tap the box next to [Set Date:]. The **Set Date** screen is displayed.



10 Tap **◄** or **▶** to select the current year.



- 11 Tap the current month, then tap the current date.
 The **Set Date** screen closes.
- **12** Tap the box next to [Time Zone:]. The **Set Time Zone** screen is displayed.



Tap the region to set the time zone, then tap [OK].



Tap ▼ next to [Daylight Saving:] and select [On] or [Off].



Tap [Next].



16 Tap [Next] and [Done].







The **Holiday** screen is displayed.

17 Tap your country or region in the **Holiday** screen to set holidays, and tap [OK].

If your country or region is not displayed in the **Holiday** screen, tap ♠ or ♣ to scroll the list in the screen.

The **Confirmation** dialog box is displayed.

Tip

If you do not want to set holidays, tap [Cancel].

18 Tap [Yes].

The Home screen (**CLIE Organizer**) is displayed.





The screen displayed when you turn on your CLIÉ handheld and tap (Home) is called the Home screen.

The initial setup is complete.

Using your CLIÉ™ handheld with your computer

CLIE Organizer for PC and Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ stored on the supplied Installation CD-ROM must be installed on your computer. The software is used for data transfer between your CLIÉ handheld and computer, and handling data on your computer such as Address Book.

When Palm[™] Desktop for CLIÉ is installed on your computer, CLIÉ Manuals is also installed on your computer.

- For details on CLIÉ Manuals, refer to "Using CLIÉ Manuals with your computer" on page 57.

Before installing the software on your computer

- Do not simply copy the CLIE Organizer for PC or PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ folder from the supplied Installation CD-ROM to your computer. To install the software properly, follow the installation procedure described below.
- If you use Windows 2000 Professional or Windows XP, log on with a User Name in the Administrators group before installing the software.

If you have more than one CLIÉ handheld

If you have more than one CLIÉ handheld and the older version of **PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ** has already been installed on your computer, follow the installation procedure below to upgrade to the new version.

Step 1: Installing Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer

Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ is the software supplied with the Palm OS® device. You can synchronize data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer using Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ. Make sure you install this before installing CLIE Organizer for PC (page 23).

- 1 Quit all applications running on Windows[®].
- **2** Insert the supplied Installation CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.

The Installation CD-ROM window is displayed.

Note

Depending on the model or area, two Installation CD-ROMs are supplied. Insert the one that contains your language.

- 3 Select your language.
 (Only available for certain models or areas.)
- 4 Click [Next] or [CLIÉ Basic], then click [Install] to install Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ.

The setup program starts and the **InstallShield Wizard** window is displayed.

Note

If you try to install **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** when an older version of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** has already been installed on your computer, a dialog box appears on your computer window.

Follow the instruction of the dialog box to install the new version of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIE** supplied with your CLIÉ handheld.

- 5 Click [Next].
 The InstallShield Wizard window for [Setup Type] is displayed.
- **6** Select the setup type, [Complete] or [Custom]. When you select [Custom], you need to specify which software you want to install and where to be installed.

The following steps explain when you select [Complete].

- 7 Click [Next].
 The InstallShield Wizard window for [Select User] is displayed.
- **8** Enter a user name and click [Next]. The **InstallShield Wizard** window for [Ready to Install the Program] is displayed after entering any user name you prefer.

Note

If you have more than one CLIÉ handheld

Enter a user name that is different from the one you use for another CLIÉ handheld. If you set an identical user name for multiple CLIÉ handhelds, errors may occur.

Tip

If you want to transfer data between CLIÉ handhelds

9 Click [Install].

Installation of Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ starts.

"InstallShield Wizard Completed" message is displayed in the **InstallShield Wizard** window when the installation is complete.

10 Click [Finish].

The **Sony CLIÉ Handheld Registration** window is displayed for models for the U.S.A., Canada, and Europe only.

Tip

If you do not want to sign up for the customer service, click **w** to deselect [Register your CLIÉ].

Installation of Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer is complete.

If you want to register your CLIÉ handheld, go to "Step 2: Registering your CLIÉ handheld".

Step 2: Registering your CLIÉ handheld

You can register your CLIÉ handheld by following the on-screen instructions. With your permission, Sony will keep you informed of special opportunities. Also, your registration information helps Sony assist you if you call for customer support.

All of the information you provide is confidential.

Notes

- To register your CLIÉ handheld online, you need to have an access to the Internet.
- You need to register again if you purchase a new CLIÉ handheld.

Tip

If you want to register your CLIÉ handheld later, click **X** at the top right of the **Sony CLIÉ Handheld Registration** window to close.

When you complete the registration and close the **Sony CLIÉ Handheld Registration** window, the **Installation CD-ROM** window is displayed.



Step 3: Connecting your CLIÉ handheld and computer via the USB cable


You can synchronize data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer by connecting them with the supplied USB cable after installing **PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ**.

About the USB cable


The supplied USB cable has two connectors. Connect the "A" plug to the USB port of your computer and the mini "B" plug to the plug adapter.



1 Connect the mini "B" plug of the USB cable to the plug adapter (①), then connect the plug adapter to the interface connector of your CLIÉ handheld (②).



2 Connect the "A" plug of the USB cable to the USB port of your computer.




Note

Make sure you connect the USB cable directly to a USB port of your computer. If the USB cable is connected to a computer via another device, such as a USB hub, the HotSync[®] operation may not work properly.

Step 4: Entering a user name for your CLIÉ handheld

1 Tap [Applica...] from the Home screen of your CLIÉ handheld.

The **Applications** screen is displayed.



2 Tap **(** (HotSync) in the **Applications** screen. The **HotSync** screen is displayed.



3 Tap **(** (HotSync) in the **HotSync** screen.

The HotSync[®] operation starts and the installation for the required software starts automatically.

4 Click [OK] when your user name is displayed in the **Users** window of your computer.

A beep is heard from your CLIÉ handheld and the HotSync® operation starts.

Your user name entered for **CLIE Organizer for PC** is also registered in your CLIÉ handheld.

When the setup is complete, "HotSync operation complete." will be displayed on your CLIÉ handheld.

Note

If you have more than one CLIÉ handheld, the user name for your old CLIÉ handheld may be displayed. In this case, select the user name you entered in step 8 in "Step 1: Installing PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer" on page 18.

Follow the steps below to install **CLIE Organizer for PC** on your computer.

Step 5: Installing CLIE Organizer for PC on your computer

To synchronize the data created on **CLIE Organizer** (a specific application to your CLIÉ handheld) between your CLIÉ handheld and computer, **CLIE Organizer for PC** must be installed on your computer.

Tip

If you want to assign the CLIE Launcher or Palm OS^{\otimes} Standard screen to the Home screen, and not using **CLIE Organizer**, you do not need to install **CLIE Organizer for PC** on your computer.

- → For details on assigning the Home screen, refer to "CLIÉ handheld™ basic operations: Using the CLIE Launcher (or Using the Palm OS[®] Standard screen)" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- 1 Click [Back] or [CLIÉ Basic], and click [Install] for CLIE Organizer for PC in the Installation CD-ROM window of your computer.
- 2 Click [Install] to install CLIE Organizer for PC.
 The setup program starts and the InstallShield Wizard window for CLIE
 Organizer for PC is displayed.
- **3** Click [Next].

 The **InstallShield Wizard** window for [Ready to Install the Program] is displayed.

- 4 Click [Install].
 Installation of CLIE Organizer for PC starts. "InstallShield Wizard Complete" message is displayed in the InstallShield Wizard window when the installation is complete.
- Click [Finish]. The Image Converter window is displayed. Image Converter is required to be installed to use CLIE Organizer for PC. Follow the onscreen instructions. The Installation CD-ROM window is displayed again after installing Image Converter.
- **6** Click [Finish] in the **Installation CD-ROM** window of your computer.

Installation of CLIE Organizer for PC on your computer is complete.

Installing the supplied applications on your CLIÉ™ handheld

You can install applications from the supplied Installation CD-ROM by following the procedure below.

You must install **CLIE Organizer for PC** (or **Palm™ Desktop for CLIE**) on your computer, before installing the supplied applications on your CLIÉ handheld. Your CLIÉ handheld must be connected to your computer via the USB cable.

Note

The supplied applications are designed to operate on your CLIÉ handheld only. Compatibility with other CLIÉ handhelds or Palm OS® PDAs is not guaranteed.

Installing the applications from the supplied Installation CD-ROM

- 1 Quit all applications running on Windows[®].
- 2 Insert the supplied Installation CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.
 The Installaton CD-ROM window is displayed.
- **3** Select the type of application you want to install, such as [CLIÉ Utilities].
- 4 Click [Install] to install the application. Follow the on-screen instructions.
- To install the application on your CLIÉ handheld, tap (HotSync) in the HotSync screen.

 The HotSync® operation starts and the selected application is transferred and installed on your CLIÉ handheld.
- **6** Click [Finish] in the **Installation CD-ROM** window of your computer.

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You can also install applications on your CLIÉ handheld using the function of CLIE Organizer for PC (or Palm™ Desktop for CLIE).

Basic operations of your CLIÉ™ handheld


This chapter explains how to turn on/off your CLIÉ handheld, start an application, enter text, synchronize with your computer, take a picture, and perform a reset.

Turning on/off your CLIÉ™ handheld

Turning on your CLIÉ handheld

Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch.

Your CLIÉ handheld turns on, and the last screen you viewed is displayed.



Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch

Note

When you slide and hold the POWER/HOLD switch for more than 2 seconds, the backlight of the LCD display turns on or off.

Tip

If you cannot turn on your CLIÉ handheld

Did you fully charge your CLIÉ handheld?

To turn off your CLIÉ handheld

Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch again.

Using an application

To use your CLIÉ handheld, you need to start an application.


The following explains how to start an application from the Home screen (**CLIE Organizer**).

Displaying the Home screen

What is the Home screen?

The screen displayed when you turn on your CLIÉ handheld and tap (Home) is called the Home screen. When you purchase your CLIÉ handheld, **CLIE Organizer** is assigned to the Home screen by default.

When you turn on your CLIÉ handheld for the first time, the **Date Book** screen of **CLIE Organizer** is displayed. The next time you turn on your CLIÉ handheld, the last screen viewed of **CLIE Organizer** is displayed.



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You can also assign the CLIE Launcher and Palm OS® Standard screen to the Home screen.

- → For details on switching to the Palm OS[®] Standard screen, refer to "CLIÉ™ handheld basic operations: Using the Palm OS[®] Standard screen" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).

Starting an application from CLIE Organizer

What is CLIE Organizer?

CLIE Organizer is an essential application that manages all applications installed on your CLIÉ handheld. You can start an application from the application tabs which include Date Book, Address Book, To Do List, Free Notes, Memo Pad, Viewer, Reference, and Applications. You can also synchronize the data you entered in CLIE Organizer with CLIE Organizer for PC installed on your computer.

Using the applications of CLIE Organizer

You can switch the screen by tapping an application tab you want to start.



Date Book

You can manage your schedule. You can also enter handwriting or put pictures and stickers.

Address Book

You can manage names, addresses, or telephone numbers. Multiple addresses can be listed with pictures attached.

To Do List

You can manage tasks and events. Tasks and events can be listed, given priority, or displayed by category.

Free Notes

You can take handwritten memos. Stickers, pictures, voice memos, and movie files can be attached to memos.

Memo Pad

You can take text format memos. Text files created on your computer can also be read.

Viewer

You can display the list of pictures, movie files, voice memos, and Free Notes memos.


You can also tap the files to view or play.

Reference

You can use some reference items, such as [Conversion Table], [Sizes], and [Temperatures and Precipitations], for useful information. New items can be added later.

Starting other applications

1 Tap [Applica...] in **CLIE Organizer**. The **Applications** screen is displayed.



Tip

You can also display the **Applications** screen by tapping (Home) repeatedly.

2 Tap the application icon you want to start. The selected application starts.

Quitting the application

You do not need to save data manually on your CLIÉ handheld as you do on a computer, although some applications require data be saved.

▶ For details, refer to the "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

To switch from one application to another, perform either of the following methods.

- Tap a tab to start another application. If you are using an application other than the applications of CLIE Organizer, return to the Home screen once and tap a tab.
- ▶ Press the application button (page 32) to start another application. (Only the application that is assigned to the application button.)

Other ways to start an application


You can also start an application using the Jog Dial $^{\text{TM}}$ navigator, BACK button, or application buttons.

Using the Jog Dial™ navigator and the BACK button


How to operate

Use your index finger to operate the Jog Dial™ navigator and the BACK button on the back of your CLIÉ handheld while you are looking at the screen of your CLIÉ handheld.

On the back of your CLIÉ handheld




1 Press the BACK button when the Home screen is displayed. The current application is selected.






2 Rotate the Jog Dial™ navigator to select an application to start. An application is selected.





3 Press the Jog Dial[™] navigator. The selected application starts.






Tip

To select an application by category

Tap at the top right of the **Applications** screen to select the category you want.




Pressing the application buttons

You can also start the applications by pressing the application buttons.

The default setting of the application buttons are:

Date Book, Free Notes, and CLIE Organizer.



Tips

- Even when your CLIÉ handheld is off, you can start an application by pressing one of the application buttons.
- When you press (CLIE Organizer), the following occurs.
 When operating CLIE Organizer:

The next screen of the CLIE Organizer application (PIM) will be displayed.

When operating applications other than CLIE Organizer, or your CLIÉ handheld is off:

The last screen viewed of the CLIE Organizer application (PIM) will be displayed.

- · You can assign your favorite applications to the application buttons.
 - → For details, refer to "Customizing your CLIÉ™ handheld (Preferences): Assigning applications to application buttons" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- ② (Data Assistant) is not an application button (page 36). You cannot assign your favorite applications to this button. No application starts by pressing ② (Data Assistant) while your CLIÉ handheld is off.


Entering text

Using Graffiti® 2 writing to enter text

Graffiti[®] 2 is a unique writing method for quickly and easily entering text into CLIÉ applications. Text is entered in the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area using the supplied stylus. Graffiti[®] 2 recognizes your handwriting and immediately converts it to typed text.

Using the Graffiti® 2 writing area of your CLIÉ handheld

You need to write the Graffiti[®] 2 strokes in the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area in the lower screen of your CLIÉ handheld to enter text. The Graffiti[®] 2 writing area is divided into two parts.



You need to write the Graffiti[®] 2 strokes in the left side of the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area for lower-case letters, the right side for numbers, or write the strokes across the division line for upper-case letters. Also, you need to activate Symbol mode to write symbols in the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area.

Entering text


You need to start an application and display the screen in which you want to enter text.

Follow the steps below to enter text.

- 1 Start an application, such as **Date Book**, in which you want to enter text.
- **2** Tap a line for the insertion point where text is to be entered.
- **3** Write the Graffiti[®] 2 strokes in the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area.

Displaying the on-screen Graffiti 2 Help

To assist with the Graffiti[®] 2 writing, you can display the on-screen Graffiti 2 Help by dragging the stylus from the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area in the lower part of the screen, to the top of the screen. Graffiti 2 Help opens a series of screens that show the character set of Graffiti[®] 2 writing.





Other ways to enter text

There are some other ways to enter text into your CLIÉ handheld. You can use whichever is the most comfortable for you.

Handwriting system

There is another way of using the handwriting system besides **Graffiti® 2**.

You can enter text on your computer using **CLIE Organizer for PC** (or **PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ**) and then transfer it to your CLIÉ handheld via the HotSync[®] operation.

Using data

You can use data from another application to easily create new data in an application.

You can use data efficiently by following procedures.

Creating new data from the text data of other applications

For example, follow the steps below to use data from another application in **Address Book**.

- 1 In an application other than Address Book, drag the text you want to use with the stylus.
- Press (Data Assistant).
 The menu is displayed in the right of the screen.
- **3** Tap [New Address data]. The **New Address data** screen is displayed and the text you selected is displayed in the center of the screen.
- 4 Select the portion of the text (1), tap ▼ to select an option (2), and then tap [Copy to field] (3).

 The text portion you selected is displayed in the upper screen (4).



5 Tap [OK].

Address Book starts and the data you created is displayed.

Tips


- If you want to create new data in **Date Book**, tap [New Date Book data] in step 3 and then tap [Time:] and [Date:] in the displayed **New Date Book** data screen.
- If you want to create new data in To Do List, Memo Pad, or CLIE Mail, tap [New To Do data (New Memo data, or New E-mail)] in step 3 to start the application. The text you selected will be displayed in the screen.
- If you select text that includes a mail address and tap [New E-mail], CLIE
 Mail starts. The text you selected will be displayed as the outgoing mail
 address.

If you select text that includes a URL and tap [Open with browser], **NetFront v3.1 for CLIE** starts.

Creating new data by searching the text data of other applications

For example, follow the steps below to create new data by searching the data in **Address Book**.

- 1 In an application other than Address Book, drag the text you want to search with the stylus.
- Press (Data Assistant).
 The menu is displayed in the right of the screen.
- Tap [Address Search].
 The **Search** screen is displayed and the list you searched is displayed.



4 Select the operation you want for the search results.

You can select the following operations.

1 [\mathbf{V}]: Tap to display the search results in other applications.

[2] [Detail]: Select the data from the search results, and tap this to display detailed information on the data. When you select the data of Date Book, Address Book, or Free Notes, you can also select the item in the To Do Detail, Address

Detail, or Free Notes Detail screen.

3 [Add]: Select the data from the search results, and tap this to add the data to the field in the application you previously worked.

Note

[Add] is activated only when the cursor is focused on the field where entering text is possible and (Data Assistant) is pressed.

[4] [GoTo]: Select the data from the search results, and tap this to start the application in which the data is saved.

[5] [Search]: Enter text in the text field, and tap this to search the data. You can also search the data within the search results by tapping ▼ of [6] and selecting [Within Results].

When Searching data without selecting text

If you do not select text in step 1, but you press (Data Assistant) for searching, no search result will be displayed in the **Search** screen. In this case, you can still search by entering text in the text field.

Synchronizing data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer by entering a schedule event (the HotSync® operation)

What is the HotSync® operation?

The HotSync® operation is an easy operation that allows you to synchronize data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer, back up the data of your CLIÉ handheld to your computer, and install add-on applications.



- Enter a schedule event and tap [OK].
 The schedule event is displayed in the Date Book screen.

5 Drag an image file in the contents field with the stylus to where you want to put it.

CLIE Organizer for PC starts and the **Date Book** window is displayed.



Tip

You can also click [Start], select [Programs] ([All Programs] for Windows XP)-[Sony Handheld], and click [CLIE Organizer for PC] to start the software.

2 Click the day you entered the schedule event in the calendar.

The schedule event you entered is displayed.

Making a backup is recommended

If problems occur, even those requiring a hard reset, you can restore your CLIÉ handheld to the same state as it was at the last HotSync[®] operation.



- By taking pictures, hold your CLIÉ handheld firmly with both hands and press the CAPTURE button slowly.
- After the CAPTURE button is pressed when the viewfinder blacks out, your CLIÉ handheld captures an image. At this moment, do not move your CLIÉ handheld, otherwise the picture will be blurred.
- Your CLIÉ handheld is equipped with a flicker control feature. However, flicker may occur under certain conditions. To minimize flicker if it occurs, avoid using under fluorescent lighting.
- Since the brightness and color of the screen are in adjustment for the first 2-3 seconds after starting CLIE Camera, be sure to check the image on-screen before shooting.

Viewing pictures

You can view the last three pictures taken by tapping them in the Image Thumbnail Display below the **CLIE Camera** screen.

Tip

If the Decuma Input area or Graffiti[®] 2 writing area is displayed, tap **!** (Resize) in the status bar to display the Image Thumbnail Display.

You can view other taken pictures in **CLIE Viewer** by tapping (CLIE Viewer) on the **CLIE Camera** screen.

Recording/Playing back a voice memo (Voice Recorder)

Recording a voice memo

1 Slide down the VOICE REC switch.

- There are two modes of recording for voice memo, [High] (to record at
 meetings or in a quiet and/or spacious place) and [Low] (to record dictation

- **2** Slide down the VOICE REC switch again to stop recording.

Restarting your CLIÉ™ handheld

Normally, you do not need to reset your CLIÉ handheld. However, if your CLIÉ handheld does not turn on or respond, performing a soft reset may solve the problem.

To reset your CLIÉ handheld, follow the procedure below.

Performing a soft reset

All records and add-on applications stored on your CLIÉ handheld are retained even after performing a soft reset.

Gently press the RESET button with the stylus.

The system shuts down and your CLIÉ handheld restarts.

After restarting, it displays "palm POWERED", "SONY" and "CLIÉ", followed by the **Preferences** screen for setting up the time and date.



Notes

- After the RESET button is pressed, it takes a while before the Preferences screen is displayed. Do not press the RESET button again while resetting.
- Do not press the RESET button with anything other than the stylus, as a malfunction may occur.
- Do not press any other buttons when you press the RESET button.

Performing a hard reset


If a soft reset does not solve the problem, you may need to perform a hard reset to restart your CLIÉ handheld.

Notes

- All records and add-on applications stored on your CLIÉ handheld will be erased by performing a hard reset.
- Perform a hard reset only if a soft reset does not solve the problem.
 However, you can restore the data if you have made a backup on your computer via the HotSync[®] operation*.
 - * Note that some data cannot be backed up.
 - → For details, refer to "Backing up your CLIE™ handheld data and applications" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- Do not press any other buttons when you press the RESET button.
- 1 Slide down and hold the POWER/HOLD switch.
- **2** Press the RESET button gently with the stylus, and then release the stylus.

Note

Keep the POWER/HOLD switch held down.




3 Wait for more than three seconds after the **palm POWERED** screen is displayed, and release the POWER/
HOLD switch.

The message "Erase all data?" is displayed.

4 Press 🖃 (the Left button) on your CLIÉ handheld.

The Left button is on the left side when the display of your CLIÉ handheld is face up.



Tip

If you want to cancel the hard reset, press any button other than (the Left button).

The hard reset is performed.

After restarting, your CLIÉ handheld displays "palm POWERED", "SONY" and "CLIÉ", followed by the **SETUP** screen. Refer to "Step 2: Performing the initial setup after turning on your CLIÉ handheld for the first time" on page 9 for the initial setup.

After a hard reset, only the current date and time are retained. Formats, Preferences, and other controls revert to the factory settings.

Notes

- After the RESET button is pressed, it takes a while before the **Setup** screen is displayed. Do not press the RESET button again while resetting.
- If (the Left button) is not pressed long enough, the hard reset may not be performed.
- (Only available for certain models or areas.) In order to change the language setting that you have initially selected, you need to perform a hard reset.





Making a backup of the data or applications on your CLIÉ handheld

Sony recommends that you make a backup of your data in case of unexpected problems. Backing up your data will ensure that it can be restored again on your CLIÉ handheld, even if you have to perform a hard reset.

Making a backup using Memory Stick Backup

Use "Memory Stick" media and **Memory Stick Backup** on your CLIÉ handheld to back up data and applications on your CLIÉ handheld.

* "Memory Stick" media (sold separately) is required. For details, refer to "Backing up your CLIÉ™ handheld data and applications: Backing up data and applications to "Memory Stick" media using Memory Stick Backup" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).

Making a backup using the HotSync® operation

Data or applications on your CLIÉ handheld is backed up to your computer when the HotSync[®] operation is performed. If you need to perform a hard reset, this would erase all user data and applications stored on your CLIÉ handheld. However, the erased data and applications can be restored with the next HotSync[®] operation.

Notes

Some add-on applications (not installed at the factory), and some application
data and settings may not be backed up using the HotSync[®] operation. However,
a backup of data on your CLIÉ handheld can be made with Memory Stick
Backup.

To make proper backups, using **Memory Stick Backup** periodically is recommended.

When you need to restore data, and so on, make sure that you perform the
HotSync[®] operation immediately after you perform a hard reset. Otherwise, if
you create new data on your CLIÉ handheld between the hard reset and
performing the HotSync[®] operation, the data may be lost.

 My CLIÉ handheld does not recognize "Memory Stick" media, or an error occurs

My CLIÉ handheld does not work properly

I cannot turn on my CLIÉ handheld

► Is the POWER/HOLD switch of your CLIÉ handheld in HOLD mode (page 88)? Your CLIÉ handheld does not work when the POWER/HOLD switch is in HOLD mode. Make sure you release HOLD mode.

Note

If you press the application buttons, Data Assistant button, or CAPTURE button, slide down the VOICE REC switch, or open the camera lens cover during HOLD mode, the POWER LED blinks 3 times. However, your CLIÉ handheld does not operate.

- ► Has the battery power of your CLIÉ handheld run out?

 Connect your CLIÉ handheld to the AC power adapter with the plug adapter, then allow it to be charged for a few minutes before turning it on. If it turns on, continue charging for approximately five hours and then perform a soft reset (page 47).
- ► Is the connector between your CLIÉ handheld and the plug adapter dirty? You cannot charge your CLIÉ handheld if the connector is dirty. Connect and disconnect your CLIÉ handheld and the plug adapter several times to clean the connector.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button of your CLIÉ handheld (page 47).

The screen is not displayed even though the POWER LED is on

- ► Is the POWER/HOLD switch of your CLIÉ handheld in HOLD mode (page 88) ?

 The screen is not displayed when the POWER/HOLD switch is in HOLD mode. Make sure you release HOLD mode.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button of your CLIÉ handheld (page 47).

My CLIÉ handheld does not respond

- ► Is the POWER/HOLD switch of your CLIÉ handheld in HOLD mode (page 88)? Your CLIÉ handheld does not operate when the POWER/HOLD switch is in HOLD mode. Make sure you release HOLD mode.
- ► Is your CLIÉ handheld placed near the IR port of your computer?

 Move your CLIÉ handheld away from the IR port of your computer except when performing the IR HotSync® operation, as a malfunction may occur. You can also disable the IR feature by selecting [Off] next to [Beam Receive:] in [General] of the **Preferences** screen.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button of your CLIÉ handheld (page 47).

My CLIÉ handheld keeps turning itself off

➤ Your CLIÉ handheld is designed to turn itself off after a period of inactivity (Automatic power-off). You can set the automatic power-off time by selecting time for [Auto-off After:] in [General] of the **Preferences** screen.

Note

The maximum idle time is 3 minutes.

- → For details, refer to "Customizing your CLIÉ™ handheld (Preferences): Setting the automatic power-off time" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- ▶ Did you set [After a preset delay] from [Auto Lock Handheld:] in the **Security** screen? If you set [After a preset delay] from [Auto Lock Handheld:], your CLIÉ handheld may turn off after a shorter period even if you set the automatic power-off time.
 - For details, refer to "Protecting your data with a password: Locking your CLIÉ handheld with a password (Data protection)" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).

My CLIÉ handheld does not produce any sounds

- ▶ Is [System Sound:] in [General] of the **Preferences** screen set to [Off]?
 - → For details, refer to "Customizing your CLIÉ™ handheld (Preferences): Setting sounds" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- ► Adjust the volume settings in the **Adjust Volume** dialog box displayed by tapping in the status bar (page 94).

Tip

If [Muting] is selected in the **Adjust Volume** dialog box, all sounds, including audio, are muted.

The backlight does not turn on when I adjust the brightness level

▶ If the brightness is set to the lowest level, the display may be illegible. However, this is not a malfunction.

The LCD display cannot be viewed properly

- ▶ Depending upon the angle of vision, the brightness may be uneven, however, this is not a malfunction. You can adjust the brightness level in the **Adjust Brightness** dialog box displayed by tapping at the bottom left of the Graffiti 2 writing area.
- ▶ If the backlight is off, you can turn it on by sliding down the POWER/HOLD switch and hold it for more than two seconds.

Applications do not operate properly after a soft reset is performed

▶ If you encounter application problems (such as improper operations, unusual display, or freezing during a soft reset) after you performed a reset, the reset may not be completed properly. In such a case, perform a soft reset once again (page 47). If you still cannot solve your problem, try a hard reset (page 48).

Notes on performing a reset

- After performing a reset, do not press the RESET button of your CLIÉ handheld again until the Preferences screen or the Setup screen is displayed.
- If you perform a hard reset, all records and add-on applications stored on your CLIÉ handheld will be deleted.

Error messages

► If there is insufficient memory space in your CLIÉ handheld or "Memory Stick" media, applications may not work properly. Delete any unnecessary data/files.

Tip

You can check the free memory space in your CLIÉ handheld or "Memory Stick" media by tapping \square (MS) in the status bar and selecting $\lceil \nabla \rceil$ Handheld or $\lceil \nabla \rceil$ MS next to [Device:] in the displayed **Media Info** dialog box.

I cannot enter text properly

My CLIÉ handheld does not recognize handwritten characters (when using Graffiti® 2)

- ► To have your CLIÉ handheld recognize handwritten characters entered with the stylus, you must use **Graffiti® 2**.
 - ► For details, refer to "Entering text on your CLIÉ™ handheld: Using Graffiti® 2 writing to enter text" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- ► Make sure you enter the Graffiti[®] 2 strokes in the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area.
- ► Make sure you enter the Graffiti[®] 2 strokes for letters in the left side of the Graffiti[®] 2 writing area and numbers in the right side.
- ► Check that **Graffiti® 2** is not shifted into Symbol mode.
 - ► For details, refer to "Entering text on your CLIÉ™ handheld: Using Graffiti® 2 writing to enter text" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- ► If the letter "L" is registered as a menu command for an application, the letters "K", "T", "I", and "X" will not work as menu command.
- ► How to enter Graffiti® 2 characters faster and more accurately.
 - → For details, refer to "Entering text on your CLIÉ™ handheld: Using Graffiti® 2 writing to enter text" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).
- ► Adjust the stylus periodically to reduce problems associated with stylus writing and reading, in **Graffiti® 2** for example.

My CLIÉ handheld does not recognize handwritten characters (when using Decuma Input)

- ▶ Refer to "Decuma Input" in the "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format) and try writing again using **Decuma Input**.
- ▶ If your handwriting cannot be recognized correctly as numbers or special characters in General characters mode, switch the Decuma Input area from General characters mode to Numbers and special characters mode.
 - ➤ For details, refer to "Entering text on your CLIÉ™ handheld: Using Decuma Input to enter text" in the "Handbook" (PDF format) or "Decuma Input" in the "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

I cannot perform the local HotSync® operation

Verifying your CLIÉ handheld

- ► Is the connector between your CLIÉ handheld and the plug adapter dirty?

 Connect and disconnect your CLIÉ handheld and the plug adapter several times to clean the connector.
- ► Are your CLIÉ handheld with the plug adapter and the USB cable properly connected (page 20)?
- ► Is there sufficient memory space in your CLIÉ handheld?

 Delete any unnecessary data/files and then perform the HotSync® operation again.
- ► Are you using the same user name that is used for another CLIÉ handheld? Change the user name.

Verifying your computer

► Are Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ and CLIE Organizer for PC installed?

Note

CLIE Organizer for PC cannot be installed before installing Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer.

- ► Is the operating system on your computer compatible?

 The following operating systems are compatible with your CLIÉ handheld. Operating systems other than the following are not supported.
 - · Microsoft Windows 2000 Professional
 - · Microsoft Windows Me
 - · Microsoft Windows XP Home Edition
 - · Microsoft Windows XP Professional

Note

Upgrade versions of operating systems are not supported.

- ► If you are using Windows 2000 Professional or Windows XP, log in as an "Administrator."
- ► Is the USB cable properly connected to your computer (page 20)?
- ► Is (MotSync) displayed in the task tray (Notification area) at the bottom right of your computer window?
 - If not, click [Start], select [Programs] ([All Programs] for Windows XP)-[Sony Handheld], and click [HotSync Manager] to start **HotSync Manager**.
- ► Is [Local USB] in the menu selected? (You can display this by clicking (HotSync) in the task tray (Notification area).)

 If not, select [Local USB].

- ► Is the USB port active?

 Check whether the USB port works normally by connecting another USB device, such as a USB mouse.
- ▶ If you use an extended terminal devices for laptop computers, such as a port replicator, you may not be able to use either the port replicator or the USB port of your computer.
- ► Quit all applications other than CLIE Organizer for PC (or Palm[™] Desktop for CLIÉ).

If you cannot perform the HotSync[®] operation even after following the above instructions, perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button of your CLIÉ handheld (page 47).

For particular problems regarding the HotSync® operations, refer to the following.

I cannot start the HotSync[®] operation by tapping **⑤** (HotSync) on the HotSync screen

- ► Ensure [Local] and [Cradle/Cable] are selected in the **HotSync** screen.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button of your CLIÉ handheld (page 47).

I cannot cancel the HotSync® operation

- ► You may not be able to stop the HotSync[®] operation by tapping [Cancel] for over ten seconds after you start the USB HotSync[®] operation. Try again after a while.
- ► If you disconnect your CLIÉ handheld and computer during the HotSync[®] operation, the HotSync[®] operation will not perform correctly.

 In such a case, perform a soft reset (page 47).
- ► If you cannot stop the HotSync[®] operation even by tapping [Cancel], perform a soft reset (page 47).

It takes a long time to complete the HotSync® operation

► Depending on the application you are using, it may require time to complete the HotSvnc® operation because of large data/file sizes.

Data cannot be synchronized with some applications using the HotSync[®] operation

- ▶ Do the user names for **CLIE Organizer for PC** and **Palm[™] Desktop for CLIÉ** match the one for your CLIÉ handheld?
 - In CLIE Organizer for PC and Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ, select the user name corresponding to your CLIÉ handheld user name.

- ► Is the application set not to synchronize files?

 Click (HotSync) in the task tray (Notification area) at the bottom right of your computer window and select [Custom...] from the menu. Check that the application is set to synchronize files.
- ► Is third party backup or synchronization software installed on your computer or CLIÉ handheld?
 - In such a case, you may not synchronize some data/files using CLIE Organizer for PC (or Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ).
- ► You can synchronize Date Book, Address Book, To Do List, and Memo Pad of your CLIÉ handheld with Microsoft® Outlook or Lotus Organizer after installing Intellisync Lite on your computer.

However, if Date Book data is assigned to synchronize with **Microsoft® Outlook** or **Loutus Organizer** in **Intellisync Lite**, Date Book data cannot be synchronized with **CLIE Organizer for PC** and **PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ**.

Do not assign Date Book data to synchronize with Microsoft[®] Outlook or Loutus Organizer in Intellisync Lite.

- ▶ For details, refer to "Intellisync Lite" in the "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).
- ► Is there sufficient memory space in your CLIÉ handheld?

 Delete unnecessary data/files and then perform the HotSync® operation again.
- ► Is private data hidden in the **Security** screen?

 Hidden data cannot be displayed in **CLIE Organizer for PC** (or **PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ**). When you want to display hidden data, select [Show Records] below [Current Privacy:] in the **Security** screen and enter the password.

I cannot back up some data using the HotSync® operation

- ➤ Some add-on applications (not installed at the factory), and some application data and settings may not be backed up using the HotSync[®] operation. However, a backup of data on your CLIÉ handheld can be made with **Memory Stick Backup**. To make proper backups, using **Memory Stick Backup** periodically is recommended.
 - ▶ For details, refer to "Backing up your CLIÉ™ handheld data and applications: Backing up data and applications to "Memory Stick" media using Memory Stick Backup" in the "Handbook" (PDF format).

Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ does not start or cannot be selected from the menu

► Is PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ properly installed on your computer?

The hardware or software of your computer may not be compatible with PalmTM

Desktop for CLIÉ. Uninstall PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ and reinstall it.

CLIE Organizer for PC does not start or cannot be selected from the menu

- ► Is CLIE Organizer for PC properly installed on your computer?

 The hardware or software of your computer may not be compatible with CLIE Organizer for PC. Uninstall CLIE Organizer for PC and reinstall it.
- ► Is PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ installed on your computer?

 CLIE Organizer for PC cannot be installed before installing PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer.

HotSync Manager does not start. (**) (HotSync) is not displayed in the task tray (Notification area) at the bottom right of my computer window

► Reinstall Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ.

If you still cannot perform the HotSync® operation

If you cannot solve your HotSync® operation problem by following the troubleshooting tips in this manual, follow the procedure below.

Check if any "Unknown device" is listed in the Device Manager on your computer.

Note

This "Unknown device" may appear in the Device Manager only while your CLIÉ handheld tries to connect to your computer. After your CLIÉ handheld has timed out and displayed an error message on a window, it disconnects from your computer and this "Unknown device", if it was present, will disappear and you will not see it.

- 1 Right-click [My Computer] and select [Properties] from the menu. The **System Properties** window is displayed.
- 2 If you are using Windows 2000 Professional/Windows XP, click [Hardware].
- **3** Click [Device Manager].
- 4 Check if there is a device marked with 1 or 1. A device with such a mark is not operating normally. Contact the manufacturer of the device to get information on the latest device drivers.

You cannot perform the HotSync[®] operation before you install Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer

If you perform the HotSync® operation before you install the CLIÉ handheld drivers on your computer, other drivers may be installed on your computer and a problem may occur in your computer system.

Make sure you install **Palm[™] Desktop for CLIÉ** before performing the HotSync[®] operation.

Do not use a USB hub

If you connect your CLIÉ handheld to your computer via a USB hub, you may not be able to perform the HotSync[®] operation properly. Make sure you connect the USB cable directly to a USB port of your computer.

Some computers have the hub function built into their internal circuitry. Contact your computer manufacturer to check whether the USB port of your computer is connected to an internal USB hub.

Check that the USB port of your computer is enabled

Test the USB port with another device, such as a USB mouse. If that device does not work, check the BIOS setting of your computer.

In addition, check the setting in the Device Manager: Right-click [My Computer] and select [Properties] from the menu. (If you are using Windows 2000 Professional/ Windows XP, click [Hardware].) Click [Device Manager] and check that [USB controller] is displayed in the **Device Manager** window.

If USB controller is not displayed

→ For details, refer to the manual of your computer.

I cannot play music

MP3 files cannot be read or played

- ► Check that the MP3 files are located in [PALM/Programs/MSAUDIO] directory on the "Memory Stick" media.
- ► Check that the file format is supported by your CLIÉ handheld.
 - For details on file formats supported by your CLIÉ handheld, refer to "Audio Player" in the "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

I cannot use "Memory Stick" media

My CLIÉ handheld does not recognize "Memory Stick" media, or an error occurs

- ▶ Remove the "Memory Stick" media and try inserting it again.
- ▶ If the terminal part of the "Memory Stick" media is dirty, your CLIÉ handheld cannot read the data/files. Wipe the terminal with a soft cloth, such as a cotton pad.
- ➤ You cannot use "Memory Stick" media that is formatted in a device other than your CLIÉ handheld. Format it on your CLIÉ handheld.
- ▶ When the battery power of your CLIÉ handheld is running low, data/files on "Memory Stick" media may not be displayed. Charge the battery of your CLIÉ handheld.

Notes on use

Handling your CLIÉ handheld

- Make sure you do not scratch or damage your CLIÉ handheld's screen.
 Always use the supplied stylus to tap on the screen.
 Do not use a writing pen, pencil, or other sharp object on the screen.
- Do not expose your CLIÉ handheld to rain or moisture. Should water enter the circuitry through the buttons and switches, your CLIÉ handheld may be damaged.
